A true rags to riches story from Syracuse!

Three brothers from an immigrant family worked their way up through the local Syracuse theater scene to become producers and theater managers/owners. By their teens, they managed the top 3 theaters in Syracuse and began building a small empire of theaters across upstate New York. They went on to build the largest theatrical empire in the world, creating Broadway as we know it today.

Today, the Shubert Corporation is still today the largest theater owner on Broadway and its foundation is still the largest of its kind in the world, funding regional theaters all around the country (including our own Syracuse Stage).
