

OHA extends ghost walk production

Due to popular demand, Onondaga Historical Association (OHA) is extending the production of "Suite Stories: A Historic Ghostwalk of Hotel Syracuse" from 1 to 3:30 PM Saturday, Jan. 3. This is an opportunity to see the interior of the Hotel before extensive renovations begin during 2015.



Entrance is on the Warren Street side of the Hotel Syracuse in Syracuse, NY. Ghostwalk tours begin at 1 p.m. and leave every 15 minutes. Tours last ninety minutes and there is no handicap accessibility. Tours are not recommended for children under the age of 10. The Hotel Syracuse was built in 1924 during Prohibition and functioned as a hotel until it closed its doors in 2006. Ghostwalk guests will visit with "spirits" from the Hotel Syracuse past as they learn some of the stories about the days when famous visitors would stay and everyone gathered in its sumptuous public spaces.
