This year's Downtown Living Tour will feature ten stops--eight residences, plus the Erie Canal Museum and the Onondaga Historical Association, which will offer perspectives on living in downtown Syracuse through the years.

The self-guided walking tours will include a stretch on the Creekwalk, which will feature strolling musicians, according to the Downtown Committee's Lisa Romeo. There will also be a free shuttle for non-walkers.
