

**OHA AT 150****What Syracuse  
consumed**

The Onondaga Historical Association is celebrating its 150th anniversary. Here's what was going on in 1863:

The total tax collected from licenses, additions, ad valorem, and duties for the previous six months in the 23rd district (which encompassed Syracuse) was \$204,761.96. Half of this total was represented by two elements: Salt (\$59,726.56) and Distilled Spirits from grain (\$50,476.33).
